Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 5, 2006, Susan Ness, a member of the Board of Directors of Adelphia Communications Corp. ("Adelphia"), participated in a telephone conversation with Commissioner Michael J. Copps regarding the above-captioned proceeding. The discussion was centered on the complexities and timing issues associated with Adelphia's bankruptcy. Ms. Ness noted that the public interest would be greatly served by approving the proposed transactions with Comcast Corporation and Time Warner Inc. because, in addition to enabling Adelphia to emerge from bankruptcy and allowing Adelphia's innocent investors to receive compensation from a restitution fund, consumers finally would benefit from an accelerated rollout of advanced video and telephony services in areas currently served by Adelphia, and employees and local communities would have greater certainty about the future. Ms. Ness also stressed the importance of the Commission acting expeditiously to approve the transactions so that the parties may close by the July 31, 2006 deadline established in the deal documents.
