Notification re Replication/Maximization Interference Protection Deadline**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

SagamoreHill Broadcasting of Wyoming/Northern Colorado, LLC (“SagamoreHill”) is the licensee of television satellite station KSTF, Scottsbluff, Nebraska (Facility ID No. 63182). The station operates on NTSC channel 10 and, pursuant to special temporary authority (“STA”) DTV channel 29. *See* FCC File No. BDSTA-20030514AEL, as extended.¹ SagamoreHill intends to operate post-transition full-power DTV facilities for KSTF-DT on the station’s digital channel, and KSTF-DT has received a tentative channel designation on that channel. *See* FCC File No. BFRECT-20050210AQS. Pursuant to the Commission’s *Report and Order*, FCC 04-192 at ¶104, MB Docket No. 03-15 (rel. Sept. 7, 2004), a satellite station that constructs digital facilities before the end of the transition will be treated as if it met the applicable replication/maximization build-out requirement and will retain interference protection for its digital facilities until the end of the digital transition. KSTF is authorized as a satellite of KGWN-TV, Cheyenne, Wyoming. *See* FCC File No. BALCT-20031014AKZ. As a result, KSTF is not subject to the Commission’s July 1, 2006 “use-or-lose” deadline.²
