

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 11, 2006, the undersigned together with Lawrence Freedman, President, WorldNet Telecommunications, Inc. ("WorldNet"), and H. Russell Frisby, Fleischman and Walsh, L.L.P. met with Ian Dillner, legal advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and two interns, Wes Platt and Matt Warner, regarding the above-referenced docket. During this meeting, WorldNet described the lack of competition in the market for wireline services in Puerto Rico and the difficulties WorldNet has experienced in obtaining wholesale services from PRTC. WorldNet further discussed its concerns that the transaction would result in a significant deterioration of the already poor competitive conditions in Puerto Rico.
