

My Comment concern the Wireless Item that has the following wording:

"Waiver of Amateur Radio and license-exempt rules, permitting transmissions necessary to meet essential communications needs;"

I believe the wording of this item is too broad, and needs to define what specifically would be waived. In an emergency it would cause chaos to allow anyone to operate an amateur Radio station. I believe this should be stated such as to allow licensed Amateur Radio operators the ability to operate on Frequencies required to reestablish required services. i.e. If a Amateur Radio operator does not have the proper HF privileges to operate under their current license, the STA should allow them to operate on the Frequency required. But in all cases it should only be a licensed Amateur Radio Licensee operating the station. The STA should only waive the Frequency restrictions of the Amateur Licensee operating the equipment. This would allow any Amateur operator to provide communications
