

FreeEats.com, Inc. d/b/a ccAdvertising (“ccAdvertising”), by its undersigned attorney, hereby supplements the record of the above-referenced proceeding to include the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Supreme Court of North Dakota, submitted to the United States Supreme Court on July 19, 2006 (“Petition”). The Petition presents the question of whether North Dakota Century Code § 51-28-02, which restricts the making of prerecorded telephone calls to residents of that State, is preempted by the Telephone Consumer Protection Act of 1991 and the implementing rule adopted by the Commission, 47 C.F.R. § 64.1200(a)(2)(ii), as applied to prerecorded interstate telephone calls that seek to survey the recipient’s political views.
