
Re: Oral Ex Parte Presentation in WT Docket No. 05-7

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to report that yesterday, on behalf of my client QUALCOMM Incorporated ("QUALCOMM"), I met with Chairman Kevin Martin regarding QUALCOMM's Petition for Declaratory Ruling in the above-captioned proceeding.

During this meeting, I reiterated QUALCOMM's need for prompt issuance of the requested declaratory ruling in order for QUALCOMM to launch the MediaFLO service as planned, initially with Verizon Wireless as the first wireless carrier offering MediaFLO to its subscribers. I explained the substantial progress that QUALCOMM has made toward launching MediaFLO, including the substantial sums it has spent on constructing its network facilities, hiring employees, developing and refining the MediaFLO product, and inventing the innovative FLO technology. I also provided background information regarding QUALCOMM's planned content offerings. I urged the Commission to issue a ruling granting QUALCOMM's Petition for Declaratory Ruling as soon as possible.
