**Re: WC Docket 06-74: Notification of Ex Parte Meeting**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, on behalf of Fones4All Corporation ("Fones4All"), the undersigned conducted an *ex parte* meeting with the following Commission Staff: Nicholas Alexander and Adam Kirschenbaum from the Wireline Competition Bureau; Jim Bird, Joel Rabinovitz, Ann Bushmiller from the Office of General Counsel; Mark Uretsky and Jerry B. Duvall from the International Bureau. Fones4All discussed the need for the Commission to examine as a separate relevant product market the subset of the mass market made up of universal service eligible low income consumers. Such an inquiry is highly relevant in light of Congress' statutory commitment to universal service and the concomitant obligations set forth in Section 254 of the Act, as well as in light of recent Commission acknowledgement of the shockingly low and falling telephone penetration rates for the Commission's Lifeline/LinkUp programs.

In accordance with the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. Sec. 1.1206(b)(1), Fones4All is electronically filing in the above-referenced docket this letter.
