SUPPLEMENT**

Dear Sir or Madam:

This Supplement to Request for Waiver of the Replication/Maximization Interference Protection Deadline of July 1, 2006, is filed on behalf of Johnson Broadcasting of Dallas, Inc. ("Johnson"), licensee of analog television station KLDT-TV, Channel 55, and permittee of DTV Station KLDT-DT, Digital Channel 54, Lake Dallas, Texas. Johnson filed its request for waiver on June 29, 2006.

In its waiver request, Johnson advised the Commission that tower site owner, Richland Towers, has completed the installation of the broadband antenna and combiner system. Johnson also advised the Commission that it had ordered the DTV transmitter and the manufacturer was in the process of testing and verifying the performance of the transmitter. Johnson further advised the FCC that it was in the process of completing the transmitter room build-out, including electrical service, HVAC, fire protection and the control room.

On December 22, 2005, Johnson entered into a Band-Clearing Agreement with MediaFLO USA, Inc., a subsidiary of QUALCOMM. This supplement is being filed at MediaFLO's request. As stated in the June 29, 2006 waiver request, Richland Tower has



installed the antenna, feed line and combiner system. Since the filing of the June 29th waiver request, the manufacturer has delivered the transmitter, and it is ready for testing. All hardware necessary to complete construction is now at the site.

Electrical power was connected to the control room on July 23, 2006. The transmitter installation should be completed and ready to be proofed by August 21, 2006. Barring unexpected delays, Johnson has set a target date of October 20, 2006 to complete its DTV build out, and believes that an FCC Form 302 license application should be filed shortly thereafter.
