Dear Ms. Dortch:

Parker Broadcasting, Inc. ("Parker"), the licensee of KFQX(TV) and permittee of KFQX-DT, Grand Junction, Colorado, Facility ID No. 31597 ("Station"), by its attorneys, hereby submits this supplement to its request for a waiver and six month extension of the July 1, 2006 deadline by which a station outside of the top-100 markets must replicate or lose interference protection ("Replication Deadline").¹ On July 3, 2006, Parker submitted a request for waiver of the Replication Deadline because, due to circumstances beyond its control, Parker had been unable to implement its full, authorized facilities for KFQX-DT prior to the Replication Deadline.² Specifically, Parker stated that, due to an error by its equipment manufacturer, the Station received a smaller power divider than required for its digital operations. Although the equipment manufacturer had originally indicated that it would ship the Station a new power divider by mid- to late-July, the delivery of the power divider has been subsequently delayed. Consequently, Parker does not anticipate receiving the new power divider from the manufacturer until late September to early October. Parker continues to anticipate that, promptly upon receipt

of the new power divider, the Station will complete construction of its DTV facilities and file a license application for the KFQX-DT facilities.
