SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION


On August 1, 2006, Xspedius Communications, LLC (“Xspedius Parent”), on behalf of itself and its subsidiaries, and Time Warner Telecom Inc. (“Time Warner Telecom”) (Xspedius Parent and Time Warner Telecom, together, the “Applicants”) filed a request for authority to transfer control of Xspedius Parent and its listed subsidiaries (“Xspedius Certificated Subsidiaries”) as a result of the acquisition of Xspedius Parent by Time Warner Telecom (“Application”). Pursuant to Commission Staff request, the Applicants hereby supplement their Application with the following information:

As noted in the Application, the transferee in this Transaction, Time Warner Telecom, is a publicly held Delaware corporation headquartered in Littleton, Colorado. As a result of the Transaction, Time Warner Telecom will become the direct parent of Xspedius Parent, which will remain the parent of the Xspedius Certificated Subsidiaries.

Time Warner Telecom will remain the direct parent company of Time Warner Telecom Holdings Inc. (“Time Warner Holdings”), a Delaware corporation. Time Warner Holdings is wholly owned by Time Warner Telecom. Time Warner Holdings will remain the direct parent company of Time Warner Telecom Holdings II LLC (“Time Warner Holdings II”), a limited liability company organized in Delaware. Time Warner Holdings II is wholly owned by Time Warner Holdings. Time Warner Holdings will remain the general partner and 1% owner of Time Warner Telecom’s operating subsidiaries. Time Warner Holdings II will remain the limited partner and 99% owner of Time Warner Telecom’s operating subsidiaries. As noted in the Application, Time Warner Telecom’s operating subsidiaries offer local and long distance telecommunications services in 25 states. A diagram showing the current corporate structure of Time Warner Telecom and its subsidiaries is appended to the Application as **Exhibit A.**

Applicants respectfully submit that the public interest, convenience, and necessity would be furthered by grant of their Application.
