MOTION TO WITHDRAW EMERGENCY PETITION FOR WAIVER

USA Datanet Corp. (“USA Datanet”), by its attorneys, files this Motion to Withdraw its Emergency Petition for Waiver in the above-captioned proceeding. On June 28, 2006, USA Datanet filed an Emergency Petition for Waiver (“Emergency Petition”) of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“FCC” or “Commission”) requirement that interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (“VoIP”) service providers permit subscribers to update their Registered Location information as directed in the Commission’s *VoIP E911 Order*.¹ USA Datanet filed the Emergency Petition after finalizing system upgrade plans with Intrado, its provider of emergency 911 and E911 services, that required USA Datanet to temporarily disable the ability for their subscribers to update their registered Location information. The Commission has not yet issued a decision on the Emergency Petition.


Intrado’s planned system update was successfully completed without incident, and USA Datanet’s subscribers have been able to update their Registered Location information
