Supplement to Request for Waiver of Replication/Maximization  
Interference Protection Deadline**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of American Christian Television Services, Inc. (“ACTS”), the permittee of digital television (“DTV”) station WTLW-DT, Lima, Ohio (Facility Id. # 1222) (“WTLW”), we hereby supplement ACTS’ request for a waiver of the July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline. (See Petition for Waiver of American Christian Television Services, Inc. relating to WTLW-DT, Lima, Ohio, Facility Id. 1222, MB Docket No. 03-15 (filed electronically through ECFS on June 28, 2006)).<sup>1</sup>

This supplement serves to notify the Commission that ACTS has filed a FCC Form 302-DTV for a license to cover WTLW’s interim DTV construction permit. (See FCC File No. BLCDDT-20060809AFC.)<sup>2</sup> As explained in its original waiver request, ACTS cannot complete construction of WTLW’s allocated replication DTV facilities by the July 1, 2006 deadline, or anytime prior to cessation of analog broadcasting. The station’s tower is fully loaded and cannot support a combined NTSC/DTV antenna at the top. If ACTS were forced to lower WTLW’s top-mounted analog antenna to a side-mount position, it would result in a severe loss of

As a result, the station plans to operate with the interim facilities specified in the aforementioned license application until such time as analog operations cease and the station can replace its analog antenna with the digital antenna at the top of its tower.
