Notice of Discontinuance of Common Carrier Broadband Internet Access  
Transmission Service of **Telecommunications of Nevada, LLC dba XO  
Communications LLC**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the *Wireline Broadband Order*,<sup>1</sup> Telecommunications of Nevada, LLC dba XO Communications LLC ("XONV"), by its counsel, hereby notifies the Commission of its intent to potentially discontinue its provision of DSL service to 4 customers in Nevada. In connection with the migration of these customers that receive DSL services over the XO DSL network to a different underlying network, some of these customers may be disconnected. XONV is hopeful, however, that most, if not all, of the affected customers will be successfully migrated and remain customers of XONV. As noted below, XONV intends to discontinue service to the affected customers, if necessary, on **September 28, 2006**. XONV provides the following information to comply with the *Wireline Broadband Order*:

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance: XONV plans to discontinue DSL service to the affected customers, if necessary, on September 28, 2006.

3. Geographic Areas of Service Affected: Should the discontinuance be necessary, XONV will discontinue the provision of DSL service to the affected customers in the state of Nevada.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected: Should the discontinuance be necessary, XONV will discontinue the provision of DSL service to the affected customers. For the DSL customers impacted by the potential discontinuance, XONV provides internet access and the underlying wireline broadband transmission for such access which is provisioned via network facilities owned and/or leased by XO.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers: XONV has provided all affected customers written notice in accordance with the requirements of the *Wireline Broadband Order* by U.S. mail, postage prepaid, on August 7, 2006. A copy of one such notice is appended hereto.

Pursuant to the *Wireline Broadband Order*, a copy of this notice is being sent to the state public utility commission and Governor of Nevada, as well as the Special Assistant for Telecommunications at the Department of Defense.
