This is to advise you that, on July 21, 2006, Sprint Nextel Corporation filed a Petition for Review in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a), of the following orders: *Review of the Spectrum Sharing Plan Among Non-Geostationary Satellite Orbit Mobile Satellite Service Systems in the 1.6/2.4 GHz Bands*, Report and Order and Fourth Report and Order, IB Docket No. 02-364, FCC 04-134 (2004), and *Amendment of Parts 1, 21, 73, 74, and 101 of the Commission's Rules to Facilitate the Provision of Fixed and Mobile Broadband Access, Educational and Other Advanced Services in the 2150-2162 and 2500-2690 MHz Bands*, Order on Reconsideration and Fifth Memorandum Opinion and Order and Third Memorandum Opinion and Order and Second Report and Order, WT Docket No. 03-66, FCC 06-46 (2006).

Petitioner seeks review of the above-referenced FCC orders in which the FCC adopted a plan for spectrum sharing among operators in the 2495-2690 MHz bands.

The D.C. Circuit has docketed this case as No. 06-1278. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Joel Marcus.
