On August 15, 2006, Kevin Reed, John Garziglia, Greg Masters, David Oxenford, Howard Weiss, Frank Jazzo, David O'Neil, Mark Lipp, Alan Moskowitz, Tom Davidson, and Andrew Kersting, on behalf of various clients, met with Heather Dixon, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin, to discuss the importance of expeditious consideration of the issues raised in the above-referenced proceeding. The group explained that the rulemaking proposals would result in substantial public interest benefits. Specifically, the group stated that adoption of the rulemaking proposals would expedite processing of AM and FM radio station facility changes, enabling the provision of expanded service to the public at an earlier date; minimize the Commission resources required to process applications; and help meet demand by radio stations for expanded service.
