Dear Ms. Dortch:

We are filing with you, under a separate transmittal, a CD-ROM, which supplements our filing of survey data from Harte Hanks Market Intelligence on July 31, 2006.

In the Harte Hanks data filed on July 31, 2006, the category titled “Carrier” contained an entry listed as “Other.” Today’s filing disaggregates the “Other” category into two constituent elements – “Unspecified” and “Other/Telco.” Harte Hanks employed the “Unspecified” category in its survey database when a respondent stated that it did not know the name of its telecom provider. Harte Hanks employed the “Other/Telco” category in its survey database when a respondent identified a telecom provider that Harte Hanks did not track in its database.<sup>1</sup>

The “Unspecified” category consists of incomplete responses by survey respondents to the Harte Hanks surveys, because the respondents were unable to provide the requested data. As the “Unspecified” listings represent incomplete responses, this provides a basis for excluding these data for use in calculations, subject to the qualifications set forth in AT&T’s letter of July 31, 2006.

The information contained in the CD-ROM is both commercially and financially sensitive and concerns proprietary information that AT&T would not in the normal course of business reveal to the public or its competitors. Accordingly, the CD-ROM is

being submitted on a confidential basis pursuant to the Protective Order in this proceeding.<sup>2</sup>
