On August 30, 2006, Megan Delany, Doug Ike and Christin McMeley of Charter Communications, Inc., and Paul Glist and Paul Hudson of Cole Raywid & Braverman, L.L.P., met with Andrew Long, Mary Beth Murphy, Steve Broeckaert, John Wong, Mike Lance, and Brendan Murray of the Media Bureau to discuss Charter's request for a limited waiver of the integration ban filed in the above-captioned proceeding on July 14, 2006. Charter explained that grant of the requested waiver would speed and facilitate its migration to all-digital networks and would save its most price-sensitive customers millions of dollars.

Charter also explained that the devices for which waivers are sought meet all of the criteria and limitations set forth in paragraph 37 of the *Second Report and Order* issued in CS Docket 97-80 on March 17, 2005.
