Dear Ms. Gregg,

In an August 18, 2006 letter to you, Time Warner Cable ("TWC") represented that it had dropped "one other national service - ESPNU," as well as some additional, local networks. In fact, TWC also dropped ESPN2HD from the lineups of the newly acquired cable systems. Many subscribers in those markets paid an additional charge to receive ESPN2HD, and it was discontinued without notice along with the NFL Network. These subscribers paid for this service one month in advance, and, so far have not received a refund for those channels which have been removed without notice. If you are currently contemplating ordering TWC to reinstate ESPNU, to be consistent, you should also order TWC to reinstate ESPN2HD. In my opinion, this action should be taken.

I do not live in these service areas, but I believe it is in the best interests of all cable subscribers so that we will continue to be treated fairly in the future. I hope this information is usefull.
