This is an appeal to the FCC as a response to the SLC rejecting our appeal for reimbursement for Bethel School District's leased fiber WAN. I believe the following series of events clearly demonstrates the merits of our case.

- March 10, 2005 - Original Application to SLC for leased fiber for our WAN, which has always been approved in the past.
- February 15, 2006 - On SLC website it was stated that a letter was sent with same date. We never received the letter.
- March 20, 2006 - After waiting for the letter became a concern, we requested the status of YR8 - 471 (Leased Fiber WAN) and were provided a case number. (Case# 21-395845)
- March 20, 2006 - SLC declined to respond because my name was not properly submitted on form. There was no effort to contact me regarding this error, the SLC simple did not communicate.
- April 10, 2006 - Because of no movement on our case, I again requested the status of YR8 - 471 (Leased Fiber WAN) FCDL (orig. never received)
- April 10, 2006 - In response to that request I received notice that "a duplicate FCDL has been requested". (case# 21-405300)
- May 8, 2006 - After not receiving the FCDL, I, for the third time, requested the status of YR8 - 471 (Leased Fiber WAN) FCDL with reference to email sent to us on 4/10/06. (case# 21-405300)
- May 8, 2006 - The response to that request was "a second request for a duplicate FCDL was requested on May 3, 2006. Please allow seven to ten days for receipt." However they stated that the request for the duplicate letter was made on 4/10/06 but we never received any letter or further communication. (case# 21-405300)
- May 23, 2006 - Because several weeks had passed, I, for the fourth time, requested status again of YR8 - 471 (Leased Fiber WAN) It was clear the SLC was not effectively dealing with a critical funding issue at this time.
- June 1, 2006 - The response was "another request for this letter has been requested through case #21-405300." That case was filed on 4/10/06.
- FINALLY on June 13, 2006 - Through email, I received with copy of original letter dated 2/15/06. Email simply states "Attached is the copy of the FCDL letter that you requested". I was astonished that it took me four requests and constant pushing to get something that was so easily sent through email.
- June 14, 2006 - Because I finally and officially knew that our request had been denied, I requested process for appeal - only response was to go to website.
- June 15, 2006 - Submitted appeal online with all supporting documents demonstrating the fiber is our leased WAN and reimbursable in accordance with eRate rules. We included copies of the bills and the original application language both of which clearly states the service applied for and received is for "leased fiber for our WAN".
- July 20, 2006 - Received letter from SLC rejecting appeal because it postmarked more that 60 days after the date of the FCDL.

It is my belief that Bethel School District has been wronged in this process and the appeal. The appeal should have been on the merits and consideration given to the lack of appropriate communication from the SLC regarding my numerous requests.

Therefore, we are asking the FCC to step in and reverse both the appeal and funding denial based on the facts presented. In addition to this document, I have included our original application language to the SLC and a copy of the bill we receive for the service as proof of the type of service Bethel receives.
