**Re: Highland Cellular, LLC (SAC 199002)
Update Regarding Virginia ETC Service Area**

Dear Ms. Majcher and Ms. Dortch:

This letter is submitted on behalf of Highland Cellular, LLC ("Highland") to provide updated information regarding the area in which Highland serves as an eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") in Virginia. Highland was designated as an ETC in Virginia by the FCC on April 12, 2004.¹


Specifically, it has come to Highland's attention that the Verizon Virginia (SAC 195040) wire center in which it received ETC designation was incorrectly labeled as "Honaker" in the 2000 version of ExchangeInfo Plus, the exchange mapping software it used at the time it filed its petition. Highland's updated version of the same software has corrected the erroneous labeling and now labels that wire center as "Swords Creek". Highland understands the Honaker wire center to be outside of its Virginia ETC service area and to be ineligible for support. Accordingly, effective immediately, Highland will report the lines in that area as being within Swords Creek.
