On September 20, 2006, the following representatives of the Iowa Telecommunications Association met with John Hunter, Senior Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Robert McDowell: Stefani Millie, Iowa Telecommunications Association; Doug Boone, Premier Communications; Gary Clark, Huxley Communications Cooperative; Roger Kregel, Dumont Telephone Company and Justyn Miller, Kalona Cooperative Telephone Company.

We discussed the high percentage of rural Iowans who have access to broadband services and the role of a stable USF funding system in providing service to rural Iowans. We discussed the importance of the pending intercarrier compensation reform proceedings in the above-captioned matter, including the importance of allowing rural carriers to recover their network costs in order to continue serving rural Iowans with the best service and technologies. We also discussed phantom traffic and the need to be compensated for traffic hauled on our networks.
