

AFFIDAVIT

I, James G. Stokes, Controller of West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc. do hereby certify under penalties of perjury that:

1. My name is James G. Stokes. I am employed by West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative in the position of Controller. In this position, I am personally familiar with the Federal Universal Service support received by the Cooperative and how the Cooperative uses these funds.
2. Yorkville Telephone Cooperative was designated as an (ETC) eligible telecommunications carrier by the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.
3. The Company is a "rural telephone company" as defined in 47 U.S.C. §153(37);
4. The Federal Universal Service funds the Cooperative receives during the upcoming year will be used for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended, as designated by the Federal Communications Commission consistent with Section 254 (e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act. This funds will be used to provide the following supported services, as outlined in 47CFR 54.10 (a), which are available to any customer in the Cooperative's service area: single-party voice grade access to the public switched network, unlimited local usage, dual tone multi frequency signaling or its functional equivalent, access to emergency services, including 9-1-1 service, access to operator services, access to interexchange service and access to directory assistance and toll limitation for qualifying low income customers.
5. West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative follows Federal Communications Commission Part 32 accounting requirements for regulate local exchange carriers and Part 36 separations provisions used to determine high cost support amounts. As a regulated utility, West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative's accounting and separations procedures are subject to periodic National Exchange Carrier Association and Kentucky Public Service Commission reviews.
6. While continuing to receive amounts of Federal Universal Service support as described and using this support for the purpose as described, West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative does not anticipate increasing local rates nor withdrawing any services; therefore, the comparability of rates and service between the rural areas served by West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative will nor be changed because of any action on part of West Kentucky Rural Telephone Cooperative.



This letter is sent to certify that all eligible carriers subject to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority")¹ have provided self certification that federal high cost-support, including high-cost loop support, local switching support, high-cost support received pursuant to the purchase of exchanges, high cost model support, and hold harmless support, will be used only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended, consistent with 47 U.S.C. § 254(e) of the Telecommunications Act. No non-rural carriers in Tennessee are eligible to receive this support. Dear Mmes. Dortch and Majcher:

In accordance with Title 47 C.F.R § 54.316, the Public Service Commission of Kentucky hereby certifies that the residential telephone rates charged for service as of July 1, 2006, are reasonably comparable to urban rates nationwide.

In its *Order on Remand, Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, and Memorandum Opinion and Order* released in the above-referenced docket on October 27, 2003,¹ the Federal Communications Commission established an annually-adjusted nationwide rate benchmark as a "safe harbor." Based upon the "safe harbor," rates in rural, high-cost areas that are below the benchmark are presumed to be reasonably comparable to urban rates nationwide. The residential rates in rural areas served by BellSouth Telecommunication, Inc., Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company, and Windstream Kentucky East, Inc. f/k/a Kentucky Alltel Inc., the non-rural incumbent local exchange carriers operating in Kentucky, are below the current nationwide urban benchmark of \$34.58, and as such, fall within the safe harbor afforded by 47 C.F.R. § 54.316(b).
