

**DECLARATION OF
MELINDA WITMER**

I, Melinda Witmer, declare and state under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. I am Melinda Witmer, Senior Vice President, Programming, Time Warner Cable Inc. ("TWC"). In that capacity, I have been involved in TWC's operational planning with respect to the systems that TWC has recently acquired from Adelphia and Comcast.

2. I am submitting this declaration in accordance with paragraph 54 of the FCC Order released on July 21, 2006, FCC 06-105, approving the Adelphia Transactions, as defined therein, to certify TWC's compliance, after completion of the Adelphia Transactions, with the channel occupancy restrictions set forth in Section 76.504 of the FCC's rules.


3. I understand that Section 76.504 was reversed and remanded by the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, *Time Warner Entertainment Company, L.P. v. FCC*, 240 F.3d 1126 (2001). Nevertheless, now that TWC has unrestricted access to the systems acquired in the Adelphia Transactions, TWC personnel have verified the programming line-ups and channel capacity of the cable systems acquired from Adelphia and Comcast.

4. Based upon this review, TWC hereby certifies without qualification that TWC is in compliance with the requirements of remanded Section 76.504 with respect to the cable systems acquired in the Adelphia Transactions.

5. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the preceding to be true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.
