On Friday, August 18, 2006, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice-President, Regulatory Affairs, Michael Altschul, Senior Vice President and General Counsel, Paul Garnett, Assistant Vice-President, Regulatory Affairs, and Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA-The Wireless Association®, met with Bill Dever, Deputy Division Chief, and Tim Stelzig and Cindy Spiers, Attorney Advisors, Competition Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau, to discuss the Commission's *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* to enhance security and authentication standards for access to Customer Proprietary Network Information ("CPNI"). CTIA stated that its members fully share the goal of protecting customer privacy and deterring data brokers from fraudulently obtaining call records. CTIA reiterated the concerns and recommendations it raised in its comments and reply comments in the docket.
