Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 3, 2006, Thomas Jones, Willkie Farr & Gallagher, on behalf of Time Warner Telecom Inc., Mark Del Bianco, on behalf of PAETEC Communications, Inc., Karen Reidy, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, COMPTEL, Colleen Boothby, Levine, Blaszak, Block & Boothby LLP, on behalf of AdHoc Telecommunications Users Committee, and the undersigned on behalf of Mobile Satellite Ventures Subsidiary LLC met with Ian Dillner, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate.

We discussed proposed conditions to help ameliorate the harm to the market for special access services that would result if the Commission were to approve the merger of AT&T and BellSouth, in accordance with our written *ex parte* filing of Sep. 22, 2006. We also clarified that the price cap condition discussed in the written *ex parte* submission (Item 2 in Exhibit A) encompasses E1 and E3 services in addition to DS1, DS3, and certain Ethernet services.

A copy of the Sep. 22, 2006 *ex parte* filing was provided to Mr. Dillner, and is attached to this letter.
