
Dear Sir or Madam:

Jam Dance Fitness is seeking temporary exemption to the closed captioning requirements because immediate compliance with the rule will result in an undue burden (47 C.F.R. § 79.1 (f)).

Jam Dance Fitness is starting to produce a daily thirty-minute exercise/fitness show called "Get Fit with Jam". The show is scheduled to begin airing on January 30, 2006 Monday thru Friday on UPN-68, WABM-Birmingham. The show is dedicated to encouraging living a healthy lifestyle of diet and exercise to the general public with an emphasis toward inner city children and adults. We are a small two-person business. Funding for "Get Fit with Jam" will be accomplished through selling advertisements. Because this is a new and unproven show, revenues are expected to be low, but will grow as the popularity of the show increases. Solicitation for sponsorship of closed captions has garnered no support at this time also due to the fact that the show is unproven. Currently we are at a deficit but expect to break even when the show begins. Compliance with the closed captioning rule at this time would terminate our show. We produce, shoot, edit, and sell the show ourselves. Adding text to the audio portion of the 5-day per week show is very time consuming and is not a viable option at this time. We have inquired of the television station but they are currently unable to assist with closed captioning for paid programming.

Because we expect revenues to increase over time, Jam Dance Fitness requests an 18-month extension to implement closed captioning. This would allow enough time to garner the financial resources required for compliance.


