On October 4, 2006, Harold Feld of the Media Access Project, and Michael Calabrese and Jim Snider of the New America Foundation (collectively "NAF") met with Julie Knapp, Hugh Van Tuyl, Steve Martin, and Karen Rackley of OET.

NAF reiterated arguments found in recent NAF *ex parte* notices that technologies and frequencies should not be excluded at this stage. NAF described experiments designed to rebut MSTV's claims of desensitization. NAF also stated that they would appreciate opportunities to participate with other industry stakeholders in the design of the FCC's technical tests.
