On October 4, 2006, Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association®, had a discussion via telephone with Barry Ohlson, legal advisor to Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein, to discuss issues relating to a potential notice of proposed rulemaking addressing the effects of communications towers on migratory birds.

During the conversation, CTIA relayed its interest in scheduling a joint meeting with Mr. Ohlson and representatives from CTIA, PCIA, the National Association of Broadcasters and the National Association of Tower Erectors. CTIA also discussed the idea of a tentative conclusion concerning a preference for a specific type of lighting on communications towers.
