

We have 8 different programs in 6 different locations through out the Southeastern United States.

This is estimated cost. We do extra tapes and extra programs throughout the year. This will add extra cost to the project.

We are in the process of upgrading our camera for broadcasting. We going to HD format. This format will add extra charge to closed caption programs .

Yes, We have one church in our organization has been burn down completely twice over the last 6 years. The two fires set us back at least 4 years as for improving and remodeling churches in our organization. The cost of rebuilding and dealing with insurance company, attorney fees is in the amount over \$2.5 million dollars . We are trying to build our treasure to remodel some our church locations and update some outdate equipment. We have 6 churches that need to be remodel or completely rebuild. This project will cost an estimate expense of \$ 2,000,000 . We are always helping people in need. By adding this additional cost to our budget, it will put a strain on churches and helping the people that need assistance through out the communities.

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

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
