

Dear Sir or Madam:

We are requesting an undue burden waiver for closed captioning of our weekly service "Welcome Home" with Pastor Tony which airs Thursdays at 7:00 AM on WPXM, Miami, Florida.

This waiver is requested for the following reasons:

1. We are a small ministry with most of our staff being provided on a voluntary basis. All camera, production, editing and audio personnel are volunteers. We have no personnel able to provide sign language interpretation as an alternative to closed captioning.
2. We do not have the resources or means to closed caption our program in-house.
3. The time-slot we are currently in was selected due to financial limitations and funds simply do not exist to have the program closed captioned.
4. Our program airs one time per week and a check of local services which provide closed captioning services cost between \$250 and \$300 per program and thus an additional minimum of \$13,000 per year.
5. The expense of closed captioning our program far exceeds our budget and would force us to cease programming.
