Supplement to Request for Waiver of Replication/Maximization
Interference Protection Deadline**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Living Faith Ministries, Inc. ("Living Faith"), the permittee of digital television ("DTV") station WLFB-DT, Bluefield, West Virginia, we hereby supplement Living Faith's request for waiver of the Commission's July 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline. On June 30, 2006, Living Faith submitted a request for waiver of the deadline because its application to modify WLFB-DT's outstanding construction permit had not yet been granted. *See Public Notice, DTV Channel Election Issues – Compliance with the July 1, 2006 Replication/Maximization Interference Protection Deadline; Stations Seeking Extension of the Deadline*, DA 06-1255 at 3 (rel. June 14, 2006). The June 14 Public Notice required that by July 1, 2006, a station such as WLFB-DT, which (i) has a tentative channel designation for a channel other than its current DTV channel and (ii) was operating facilities on its current DTV channel pursuant to an STA which covered at least 80% of the number of viewers served by the 1997 facilities on which its replication coverage is based, must file an application to modify its construction permit to match the STA facilities and, following FCC approval, file an application for a license to cover the construction permit. On September 6, 2006, the Commission finally granted Living Faith a modified DTV construction permit for WLFB-DT, FCC File No. BMPCDT-20060629ACQ.

This supplement serves to notify the Commission that Living Faith today filed an application on FCC Form 302-DTV for a license to cover WLFB-DT's modified DTV construction permit. *See FCC File No. BLCDDT-20061012ABB*. Accordingly, Living Faith has satisfied the Commission's DTV replication/maximization requirement.

Living Faith also advises that it received a letter from the Video Division on September 7, 2006, stating that the grant of construction permit BMPCDT-20060629ACQ would result in a reduction of the facilities that Living Faith certified that it would construct as WLFB-DT's permanent digital television station, and that Living Faith's "failure to replicate or maximize in accordance with its certification will result in the loss of interference protection to those service areas not replicated or maximized." This letter is in error. As stated above, because WLFB-DT is an "80% station," Living Faith has fully complied with the FCC's replication/maximization requirements and respectfully submits that the FCC is required to continue providing interference protection for the maximized DTV facilities certified in WLFB-DT's Form 381, FCC File No. BCERCT-20041104AAD.
