Dear Ms. Dortch:

Parker Broadcasting, Inc. ("Parker"), the licensee of KFQX(TV) and permittee of KFQX-DT, Grand Junction, Colorado, Facility ID No. 31597 ("Station"), by its attorneys, hereby submits this supplement to its request for a waiver and six month extension of the July 1, 2006 deadline by which a station outside of the top-100 markets must replicate or lose interference protection ("Replication Deadline").¹ On July 3, 2006, Parker submitted a request for waiver of the Replication Deadline because, due to circumstances beyond its control, Parker had been unable to implement its full, authorized facilities for KFQX-DT prior to the Replication Deadline.²

By this letter, Parker notifies the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") that it has completed construction of the digital facilities authorized in its construction permit. See FCC File No. BPCDT-19991101AGO. On October 20, 2006, an application for a license to cover KFQX-DT's facilities was filed with the Commission, which application is pending. See FCC File No. BLCDDT-20061020ACO. Accordingly, further waiver of the Replication Deadline is unnecessary.
