AFFIDAVIT OF ARTHUR R. BLOCK

The undersigned declares under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. I am Senior Vice President, General Counsel and Secretary for Comcast Corporation ("Comcast") and have been employed by Comcast since 1989, becoming General Counsel in 2000.
2. On July 13, 2006, the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") granted its consent to the acquisition by Comcast and Time Warner Inc. ("Time Warner") of substantially all of the domestic cable systems owned or managed by Adelphia Communications Corporation ("Adelphia") and certain other transactions between Comcast and Time Warner (the "Transactions"). *See Applications for Consent to the Assignment and/or Transfer of Control of Licenses, Adelphia Communications Corp., Assignors, to Time Warner Cable Inc., Assignees; Adelphia Communications Corp., Assignors and Transferors, to Comcast Corporation, Assignees and Transferees; Comcast Corporation, Transferor, to Time Warner Inc., Transferee; Time Warner Inc., Transferor, to Comcast Corporation, Transferee*, Memorandum Opinion and Order, MB Docket No. 05-192, FCC 06-105 (rel. July 21, 2006); *see also* Erratum, MB Docket No. 05-192 (rel. July 27, 2006) (the "Erratum"). As a condition of its approval, the Commission required Comcast to certify without qualification that the requirements of section 76.504 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 76.504, the "channel occupancy rule," had been satisfied with respect to the Transactions. *See id* at ¶ 315; Erratum at ¶ 16.
3. Following consummation of the Transactions, Comcast personnel have verified the channel capacity of the cable systems Comcast acquired from Adelphia and Time Warner and the program services carried on such systems.
4. Based upon this review, I hereby certify without qualification that the requirements of section 76.504 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 76.504, have been satisfied by Comcast.
5. Under penalty of perjury, I declare the preceding to be true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.
