The purpose of this letter is to provide notice that on October 25, 2006, Jamison Prime, Chief of the Spectrum Policy Branch of the Federal Communications Commission's Office of Engineering and Technology, Policy and Rules Division, attended the semi-annual meeting of the American Petroleum Institute's (API) Telecommunications Committee. Also in attendance at the meeting (which was held at API's offices in Washington, D.C.) were Keller and Heckman LLP attorneys Wayne Black, Jack Richards and Greg Kunkle.
