On Monday, October 30, 2006, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, Paul Garnett, Assistant Vice-President, Regulatory Affairs, and Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA-The Wireless Association®, met with Bruce Gottlieb, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Michael J. Cops, to discuss the Commission's *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* to enhance security and authentication standards for access to Customer Proprietary Network Information ("CPNI"). CTIA stated that its members fully share the goal of protecting customer privacy and deterring data brokers from fraudulently obtaining call records.
