On November 7, 2006, Kelly Williams, Matthew Schwartz and the undersigned of the National Association of Broadcasters ("NAB") met with Julius Knapp, Bruce Romano, John Reed, Rodney Small and Karen Rackley of the Commission's Office of Engineering and Technology, to discuss The Rail Network, Inc.'s ("TRN") above-captioned request for waiver of Section 15.209 of the Commission's rules. Specifically, NAB urged the Commission to require that TRN submit additional technical information to support its waiver request, including data concerning TRN's alleged need for the power level proposed in its request, and quantitative evidence that TRN's proposed system will not cause harmful interference to free over-the-air FM broadcast services.
