On November 7, 2006, William Pitts, President of Government Affairs, the NTI Group, Inc. ("NTI"), and Seth Davidson of Fleischman and Walsh, L.L.P. met with Catherine Bohigian, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis, to urge that the Commission, consistent with NTI's filings in this proceeding, clarify that time-sensitive notification systems ("TSN"), such as the NTI Connect-ED educational telephone notification service, are eligible services for support under the schools and libraries program or, in the alternative, commence a rulemaking proceeding to make such changes in the rules as are necessary to designate TSN systems as eligible for support under the schools and libraries program.
