On November 1, 2006, ACS of Anchorage, Inc. (“ACS”) submitted data regarding the number of special access circuits it provides to end-user customers and to other carriers. In Attachment 2 of the *ex parte* submission, ACS indicated that General Communication, Inc., is the only carrier that purchases special access from ACS through its intrastate tariff. However, ACS has recently determined that as of September 2, 2006, **[BEGIN CONFIDENTIAL] [END CONFIDENTIAL]** purchased **[BEGIN CONFIDENTIAL] [END CONFIDENTIAL]** in Anchorage pursuant to ACS’s intrastate tariff, in addition to the **[BEGIN CONFIDENTIAL] [END CONFIDENTIAL]** it purchased from ACS’s interstate tariff.
