**Hearing Aid Compatibility Report**

Lamar County Cellular, Inc. (“Lamar”), by its attorneys, pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission” or “FCC”) *Order* in WT Docket No. 01-309,<sup>1</sup> and the subsequent *Public Notice* in the same proceeding,<sup>2</sup> hereby files its Sixth Report detailing its efforts towards compliance with the FCC’s hearing aid compatibility requirements. Lamar is including in its Sixth Report all information of which it has knowledge, but does not address those reporting requirements in the *Order* that can be adequately answered only by the individual handset manufacturers.

**I. Carrier Background**

Lamar is a small commercial mobile radio service (“CMRS”) carrier that provides GSM-based service in rural Texas.

**II. Handsets Currently Offered for Sale**

Lamar currently offers for sale GSM handsets manufactured by Nokia, Motorola, Samsung, and Sony. The specific handset models are the Nokia 1600, 6010, 6061, 6101, 6103, and 6126; the Samsung SGH-x496; the Sony z300a, z520a, and W810i; and the Motorola v190, v197, v235, U6, and V3. The Nokia 6061 and 6126; Samsung SGH-x496; the Sony z520a; and Motorola V3 handsets have been certified by the FCC’s Office of Engineering and Technology as M-rated hearing aid compatible (HAC) compliant.

**III. Hearing Aid Compatible Handset Labeling/Insert Requirement**

The Nokia 6061 and 6126; Samsung SGH-x496; the Sony z520a; and Motorola V3 handsets that Lamar has available for sale to its subscribers have labels attached on the handset's packaging indicating the U-rating of the wireless telephone.

**IV. Outreach Efforts**

Lamar intends to educate its subscribers and potential customers on the functionality of any of the hearing aid compatible handsets it is able to obtain. In addition, Lamar works with all of its customers to ensure that there are no difficulties with the performance or functionality of the handsets it offers.
