On November 16, 2006, Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA - The Wireless Association®, spoke by telephone with Joel Taubenblatt, Chief of the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's Broadband Division.

During the call, Mr. Josef and Mr. Taubenblatt discussed issues related to the timing of post-Advanced Wireless Service ("AWS") auction procedures, including an upcoming Bureau order addressing cost-sharing clearinghouse duties and responsibilities. Mr. Josef inquired into the status of any Petitions to Deny that may have been filed against winning AWS auction bidders. In addition, Mr. Josef provided an update of efforts by CTIA and PCIA – The Wireless Infrastructure Association to discuss the exchange of information necessary to administer clearinghouse functions. Mr. Josef explained that on November 8th, representatives of CTIA and Comsearch met with PCIA staff and its outside legal counsel and consultant in an effort to better understand each clearinghouse's information exchange approach. CTIA, Comsearch and PCIA representatives anticipate holding a follow-up meeting to continue the discussion on data sharing issues.
