Mr. M. Glover and Ms. S. Guyer of Verizon met with Mr. D. Gonzalez and Ms. M. Carey of FCC Chairman Kevin Martin's office and Mr. T. Navin, Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau on November 17. In reference to the above proceedings Mr. Glover and Ms. Guyer emphasized the need to ensure that advanced broadband services such as VoIP and other IP-based services remain interstate in nature and subject to federal jurisdiction, and to ensure that these services are not subjected to the economic regulations that apply to traditional telephone services, regardless of the entity that provides them.
