

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Spanish Television of Denver, Inc. ("Spanish Television"), licensee of digital television station KTFD-DT, Boulder, Colorado, this letter hereby requests the voluntary dismissal of the request for extension and waiver of the July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline filed for the station on June 27, 2006. As indicated in the waiver request, the construction of KTFD's digital facility was delayed by zoning approvals. After grant of those zoning approvals, KTFD moved forward with construction and filed a license to cover application on September 22, 2006. See FCC File No. BLCDDT-20060922AFJ. That application was granted on November 16, 2006.

Accordingly, KTFD-DT is now operating in compliance with the July 1, 2006 replication/maximization deadline, and Spanish Television hereby requests the voluntary dismissal of its request for extension and wavier as moot.
