Dear Ms. Dortch:

On 30 November 2006, Gurdeep Ball, Michael Corrigan, Cynthia Alexander, Kevin Minsky, Scott Forbes, Chuck Cosson and Paula Boyd of Microsoft met with Commissioner Adelstein and Rudy Brioche. During this meeting, a brief discussion was held relating to the above-noted dockets.

Specifically, Microsoft suggested that to the extent policy makers consider imposing regulatory obligations on VoIP services, they should focus solely on those services that substitute for traditional telephone service. Microsoft further suggested that where consumers are offered a bundle of services over an IP platform that includes VoIP service, any regulatory obligations should apply only to the PSTN-interconnected VoIP part of the bundle and only to the extent that it substitutes for traditional phone service.
