On behalf of Entravision Holdings, LLC ("Holdings"), the licensee of Station KTFN, El Paso, Texas, it is respectfully requested that the waiver of the Commission's July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference deadline to the extent that it applies to the Station, as requested by Holdings by letter, dated July 7, 2006, be dismissed as moot.

In the waiver request, Holdings advised that the waiver was predicated on Holdings completing the construction of facilities authorized for KTFN in File No. BPCDT-19991029AEX. That construction has now been completed and an application for a license to cover the construction has been submitted in File No. BLCDT-20061127ACB.


