

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 6, 2006, the undersigned, together with H. Russell Frisby, Fleischman and Walsh, L.L.P., counsel for WorldNet Telecommunications, Inc. ("WorldNet"), met with William Dever, Jodie May and Gail Cohn of the Wireline Competition Bureau, Neil Dellar, Office of the General Counsel, and David Strickland, International Bureau, regarding the above-referenced docket. During this meeting, counsel for WorldNet described the lack of competition in the market for wireline services in Puerto Rico and the difficulties WorldNet has experienced in obtaining wholesale services from PRTC. Counsel for WorldNet further discussed its concerns that the transaction would result in a significant deterioration of the already poor competitive conditions in Puerto Rico.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b) (1), this letter is being filed electronically for inclusion in the record of the above-referenced proceedings.
