Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 5, 2006, the undersigned and Mr. Charles Townsend, both representing Aloha Partners, L.P. ("Aloha"), met with Fred Campbell of Chairman Martin's office and discussed matters in the referenced proceeding.

In particular, and on behalf of Aloha, the Commission was urged to act promptly to revise its rules so as to create Spectral Power Density ("SPD") neutrality, as Aloha, Crown Castle International, Inc. ("CCI"), CTIA and many others who constitute the existing "consensus" position on this issue have urged the Commission to do in the captioned proceeding. Aloha explained that it has an interest in taking advantage of the long-anticipated rule changes and urged specifically that they be made applicable to 700 MHz licenses as well as licenses in several other wireless bands. Aloha also urged that the Commission not act on any individual request for SPD neutrality prior to acting in the rulemaking proceeding generally, in order to maintain a level playing field on the SPD issue. Aloha explained that such even-handedness is especially appropriate given that both the individual request and the requests in the rulemaking are based on the same analysis and present arguments that mirror each other.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b)(2), this notice is being submitted electronically in the above-referenced docket. In addition, one copy of this notice is being transmitted via e-mail to Mr. Campbell.
