

On December 6, 2006, David C. Eisenberg, Senior Vice President, Corporate Strategy & Development and Leonard Steinberg, Vice President and General Counsel & Corporate Secretary, both of ACS Wireless, Inc., and Mark Brennan and the undersigned of Birch, Horton, Bittner & Cherot, P.C., outside counsel to ACS Wireless, Inc. (collectively, "ACSW"), met with Angela Giancarlo, legal advisor to Commissioner McDowell, to discuss the conditions on approval that the Applicants recently proposed in the above-referenced proceeding. ACSW also reiterated its positions as stated in previous pleadings, and noted that if the Commission were to approve the transaction, certain additional safeguards would be necessary to protect against anticompetitive harm. ACSW discussed the conditions contained in its recent *ex parte*, filed December 4, 2006. ACSW also provided the attached diagram at the meeting. The diagram shows GCI's relationships with other wireless carriers in Alaska.
