
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the Greater Cincinnati Television Educational Foundation (“GCTEF”), licensee of noncommercial educational station WCET(TV), Cincinnati, Ohio, we hereby withdraw, and request dismissal of, its request for a temporary waiver of the DTV replication/maximization interference protection deadline.

GCTEF filed its request for waiver on June 28, 2006, pursuant to the FCC Public Notice *DTV Channel Election Issues – Compliance with the July 1 Replication/Maximization Interference Protection Deadline*, DA 06-1255 (June 14, 2006). As explained in that request, GCTEF’s pre-election certification had specified post-transition facilities according to the construction permit in File No. BPEDT-20000420ABE, and GCTEF had filed an application in File No. BMPEDT-20060621AAI for a minor modification of that construction permit. Due to equipment limitations, the modification reduced the WCET-DT ERP from 500 kW to 400 kW and requested a corresponding change to the station’s pre-election certification. The FCC granted the modification application on October 12, 2006, and GCTEF filed a license to cover application for the modified permit on October 31, 2006.

Accordingly, with WCET(TV)’s intended post-transition DTV facilities now constructed per the license application in File No. BLEDT-20061031AAR, the previously requested waiver of the July 1, 2006 “Use It or Lose It” DTV interference protection deadline is no longer required.
