On December 11, 2006, Gail Sanchez, David Claus, Terry Feeney and Burt Bossi, along with the undersigned, participated on a conference call with Cheryl King of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau to discuss the misuse of Internet Protocol (IP) Relay Service. AT&T proposed the creation of a database that would contain IP addresses and address ranges that have been identified as using IP relay services in an inappropriate manner. This database would be accessible via the internet to all providers for querying and downloading. Providers would be responsible for submitting addresses to the database that are identified as inappropriate. There would also be a method to request that addresses be removed from the database in the event that valid users are inadvertently blocked.
