
By this letter, Mountain Broadcasting Corporation ("Mountain"), the licensee of WMBC-TV, Newton, New Jersey and associated DTV station WMBC-DT, by its counsel, respectfully requests the voluntary dismissal of its pending request, filed on June 22, 2006, for an extension of the July 1, 2006 replication/maximization interference protection deadline for digital television ("DTV") licensees and permittees (the "Waiver Request"). As Mountain explained in the Waiver Request, due to DTV equipment delivery delays that were out of Mountain's control, an extension of the July 1 deadline was necessary to provide Mountain with sufficient time to accept delivery, install and conduct testing on that equipment, prior to filing an application for a license to cover the above-referenced construction permit.

Following delivery, installation and testing on the DTV equipment, on August 3, 2006, Mountain filed an application for a license to cover the above-referenced permit (FCC File No. BLCDDT-20060803AMO). On September 14, 2006, the Commission granted that application. Grant of that application has mooted Mountain's Waiver Request, as replication of the service area specified in the station's original DTV allotment has been achieved. Accordingly, and pursuant to a request from the Commission's staff, Mountain hereby requests the voluntary dismissal of the Waiver Request.


